ACADEMIC SKILLS TRAINING

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The Department of Defense (DoD) Voluntary Education (VoEd) Program, through the Defense Activity for Non-Traditional Education Support (DANTES), offers online, self-paced, academic skills training courses to improve a member's math and communication skills.

Online Academic Skills Course (OASC) - provides fundamental math and verbal skills improvement.

College Placement Skills Training (CPST) - offers college level math, English and writing skills training.

Both programs assess and identify the learner's strengths and weaknesses to design customized learning paths for each student. These paths improve the student's knowledge of the concepts and skills needed to excel in each area. Lessons are supported by interactive exercises, practice sets, and quizzes to help learners gauge how well they are mastering the material.
