COLLEGE ADMISSION EXAMS

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The Department of Defense (DoD) Voluntary Education (VolEd) Program, through the Defense Activity for Non-Traditional Education Support (DANTES), provides access to college admission exams that help military members meet entrance requirements. DANTES reimburses* test fees for eligible military personnel for the following college admission exams:

- ✓ **ACT® and SAT®:** demonstrates a candidate's learning potential for college entrance or officer accession programs
- ✓ **GRE®:** helps members pursue graduate school admission
- ✓ **GMAT®:** validates a member's readiness for business school admission at the graduate level

STUDENT BENEFITS:

- 📎 Saves money with DANTES reimbursement* of test fees
- 📎 Meets college admission requirements
- 📎 Strengthens candidate qualifications for enlisted-to-officer programs

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY:

All active duty, National Guard and Reserve component service members, in all military services, including the U.S. Coast Guard are eligible for DANTES-reimbursed college admission exams, at least once* per lifetime of service.

**ACT and SAT Funding:* Eligible service members may take one ACT and one SAT exam at no cost if taken at DANTES-sponsored test centers located on military installations. Reimbursement for up to two ACTs and two SATs is available for exams taken at commercial test centers.
